("MERS"), Defendant John 22 Brosnan ("Mr. Brosnan") and Defendant XZVR, Inc., formerly known as Mortgage Electronic 23 Registration Systems, Inc. ("Company Defendant") (collectively the "Parties") have entered into 24 an agreement to resolve this action (hereinafter the "Settlement Agreement"), with reference to 25 the following facts: 26 Plaintiff Mortgage Electronic Registration Systems, Inc. ("MERS") filed an ex A. 27 parte motion for temporary restraining order and order to show cause on August 6, 2009. 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August 12, 2009, the Court entered a temporary restraining order prohibiting defendants from using MERS' name and accepting service of process of documents intended for MERS, and requiring defendants to forward any documents in their possession intended for MERS to MERS' counsel (hereinafter the "TRO"). The TRO required the defendants to show cause on August 26, 2009, why a preliminary injunction should not be entered against them. The Court conducted a hearing on MERS' motion for a preliminary injunction on August 26, 2009. The Court issued a Preliminary Injunction on September 4, 2009 ("PI Order").

- B. The Court issued a Contempt Order on November 5, 2009, against Mr. Brosnan and Company Defendant for their failure to comply with the PI Order. Mr. Brosnan is the sole owner of Company Defendant. Company Defendant changed its name to XZVR, Inc., effective on March 1, 2010, as shown in the document attached as Exhibit A hereto.
 - C. Default was entered as to Company Defendant on November 19, 2009.
- D. MERS and Company Defendant have entered into a Settlement Agreement and, pursuant to the Settlement Agreement, they have agreed to the terms of this Stipulated Permanent Injunction and Default Judgment. Pursuant to the same Settlement Agreement, MERS and Mr. Brosnan will stipulate to dismissal of the remaining claims in this action upon Mr. Brosnan's satisfaction of the obligations in Paragraph 1 of the Settlement Agreement.

MERS and Company Defendant stipulate, and the Court hereby orders, as follows:

- (1) Company Defendant, together with any entity under its control or anyone acting on its behalf in any capacity, shall not engage in, commit or perform, directly or indirectly, any of the following acts:
- (a) Using or applying to register MORTGAGE ELECTRONIC REGISTRATION SYSTEMS (with or without an "S"), MERS or any confusingly similar designations, as a mark, business name, domain name, email address, meta-tag, keyword, or otherwise except for what strictly qualifies as nominative fair use, using either names or marks only to refer specifically to the Delaware entity that is a plaintiff in this action, and only as much as is required to convey that identification and only in such manner so as not to cause likelihood of confusion; Company Defendant cannot claim any ownership rights in either designation; and

1	(b) Accepting service of process or other documents intended for MERS,		
2	including summonses, complaints, subpoenas, or any other legally-required notices naming or		
3	involving mortgage liens held by Mortgage Electronic Registration Systems, Inc., a Delaware		
4	corporation.		
5	(2) Company Defendant shall deliver or cause to be delivered to MERS all documents		
6	and things that it, or any person or entity under its control or anyone acting on its behalf in any		
7	capacity, receives that were addressed to or otherwise intended for MERS. Such documents shall		
8	be sent within three business days of receipt, and shall be sent directly to MERS' in-house		
9	counsel, by first-class mail or other mutually agreeable method, addressed as follows:		
10	Mortgage Electronic Registration Systems, Inc.		
11	c/o Joseph J. Patry, Counsel 1818 Library Street, Suite 300		
12	Reston, VA 20190 (3) This Court, or a magistrate designated by the Court, shall retain jurisdiction with		
13	respect to enforcement of this Stipulated Permanent Injunction and the Settlement Agreement, the		
14	terms of which are incorporated herein by reference. The Court retains broad discretion to		
15	impose sanctions, including fines, an award of attorneys' fees, issue sanctions, and/or		
16			
17	Order.		
18	(4) The above terms shall supersede the terms of the Preliminary Injunction with		
19	respect to Company Defendant.		
20	(5) The Parties hereby stipulate that judgment shall be entered against Company		
21	Defendant pursuant to the terms herein.		
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1	Each Party shall bear its or his	own costs and attorneys' fees.
