 19 Pursuant to United States District Court, Northern District, Local Rule 6-2 and 7.12, Plaintiff
 20 Marshall Loskot (“Plaintiff”) and defendants Abel Hernandez, Martha E. Hernandez, and Olga
 21 Romo (sued as Olga R. Gavidia) (“Defendants”) submit the following stipulation extending the
 22 time to conduct the inspection of the premises under the Court’s Scheduling Order.

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 24 The Complaint was filed on August 17, 2009. Defendants were served by personal and substitute
 25 service, the latest on September 17, 2009.

 27 The defendants answered the lawsuit on December 3, 2010.
 28

1 Counsel for Plaintiff and Defendants have been in active discussions since mid-December
2 regarding scheduling the Joint Inspection of the premises at issue and the actual conducting of the
3 inspection. The parties had agreed to a joint inspection for January 8, 2010. However, in preparing
4 for the inspection, the parties have encountered issues with the local building department (City of
5 South San Francisco) regarding (1) the Department's view of what remedial measures may or may
6 not be allowed under local law, and (2) whether, and to what extent, local law is superseded by
7 state and federal ADA laws. Counsel for Plaintiff and Defendants have been in communications
8 with the Building Department of the City of South San Francisco on these issues. But the parties
9 do not want to expend resources in an inspection and prepare for remedial measures that may
10 ultimately be disallowed by the local authorities. Also, the parties have been in discussions about a
11 possible settlement of the case, and are actively seeking information that will affect different
12 aspects of a possible settlement (including discussions by defendant Romo with local banks and
13 the City of South San Francisco for a loan).

14 Therefore, in order to allow time to clarify these several issues, and in the interests of efficiency,
15 the parties wish to stipulate to extend the deadline for the joint inspection to January 30, 2010, and
16 respectfully request that the Court order the same.
