10 This civil rights action, filed by pro se Plaintiff Kevin
 11 Lamar Hopkins, alleges the use of excessive force and deliberate
 12 indifference to Plaintiff's serious medical needs by Defendant San
 13 Francisco Police Officer Charles August. After Defendant informed
 14 the Court that he would not be filing a motion for summary
 15 judgment, the matter was referred to the Court's Pro Se Prisoner
 16 Settlement Program for settlement proceedings, and a trial date was
 17 set for January 5, 2012.

18 The Court has been informed by Magistrate Judge Nandor Vadas,
 19 who conducted the above settlement proceedings on December 1, 2011,
 20 that the case did not settle.

21 Good cause appearing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Plaintiff
 22 shall be referred to the Federal Pro Bono Project of the Volunteer
 23 Legal Services Program, which will attempt to find an attorney who
 24 is able to represent Plaintiff in these proceedings.

25 Accordingly,

26 1. The Clerk of the Court shall forward to the Federal Pro
 27 Bono Project: (a) a copy of this Order, (b) a copy of the docket
 28 sheet, and (c) a copy of the operative complaint and relevant court

1 orders in this matter, specifically, docket nos. 1, 13, 49, 50 and
2 70.


3 2. If an attorney can be found to represent Plaintiff,
4 that attorney shall be appointed as counsel for Plaintiff in this
5 matter until further order of the Court.

6 3. All proceedings in this action are STAYED until four
7 weeks from the date an attorney is appointed to represent Plaintiff
8 in this action, or until the Court otherwise lifts the stay.

9 4. All pretrial and trial dates previously set in this matter
10 are hereby VACATED.
