If respondent fails to timely respond to this Order, the Court will deem him to be in contempt, as set for in petitioner's Application for Entry of Order to Show Cause re: Contempt, and will enter a contempt order without further notice or a hearing. If respondent timely files a response, petitioner may file and serve a written reply to such response, if any, within fourteen (14) days before the return date of this Order. All motions and issues raised by the pleadings will be considered on the return date of this Order, and only those issues raised by motion or brought into controversy by the responsive pleadings and supported by affidavit(s) or declaration(s) will be considered at the return of this Order.
