12 On November 1, 2012, Plaintiffs, Todd Ashker, et al., filed a
13 motion for administrative relief asking the Court to vacate the
14 previous case management schedule and to set new dates for
15 discovery and trial. Docket No. 143. The following day,
16 Defendants, Governor Edmund G. Brown, et al., filed a motion for
17 an extension of time to file a motion to dismiss and asking the
18 Court to vacate inconsistent case management deadlines. Docket
19 No. 147. The Court has reviewed both motions and now grants each
20 motion in part.

21 Defendants will file their motion to dismiss by December 17,
22 2012. Plaintiffs will file their response by January 17, 2013 and
23 Defendants will file their reply by January 31, 2013. The Court
24 will hear the matter at 2:00pm on February 14, 2013. A case
25 management conference will be held on the same date as the hearing
26 on the motion and the parties will submit a joint case management
27 statement one week in advance of the conference. The case
28 management deadlines set forth in the Court's May 31, 2012

1 scheduling order (Docket No. 127) are hereby vacated. The
2 deadlines will be reset as needed at the case management
3 conference on February 14, 2013. Until then, the parties should
4 continue to engage in fact discovery.

5 IT IS SO ORDERED.
