## **DECLARATION OF RAYMOND C. BROWN**

- I, Raymond C. Brown, declare:
- 1. I am a Senior Director of Software Engineering at Go Daddy.com, Inc. ("Go Daddy"), and I have been employed at Go Daddy since July, 2005. I am familiar with the process by which Go Daddy customers can redirect domains via their hosting accounts as detailed in a Go Daddy help article entitled "Redirect URLs with Your Hosting Account." I have personal knowledge of the facts set forth herein and, if called as a witness, I could and would testify competently thereto.
- 2. Customers with websites hosted by Go Daddy can use an online dashboard, the "Hosting Control Center," to redirect their website's visitors to a chosen destination, either a different location within the same site or a new website entirely. To do this, however, the domain the customer seeks to redirect must be registered with Go Daddy and must be associated with the customer's account.
- 3. Attached hereto as Exhibit 1 is a true and correct copy of a screen capture I generated showing an attempt to redirect a domain that is not hosted by Go Daddy. The "Next" button is dimmed, and the text "(must be on this account)" is colored red to indicate that the domain cannot be successfully redirected.
- 4. Attached hereto as Exhibit 2 is a true and correct copy of a screen capture I generated showing redirection of a domain that is registered with Go Daddy and is associated with the customer's Go Daddy account. In this screen capture, the "Next" button is not dimmed and the text "(must be on this account)" is not colored red, indicating that the customer can move on to the next step in the redirection process.
