11 On July 26, 2010, the Court granted Defendants Select 12 Portfolio Servicing, Inc.; Timothy J. O'Brien; Jason H. Miller; and 13 Matthew L. Hollingsworth's motion to dismiss Plaintiff Charles A. 14 Bonner's complaint. Plaintiff was given leave to amend to cure the 15 deficiencies identified in the Court's Order. The Court noted that 16 it did not appear that Plaintiff had served Defendants Bryan M. 17 Marshall, Encore Credit Corp. and Option One Mortgage Corp., and 18 directed him to provide proof of service as to these Defendants. 19 Plaintiff was warned that, if he did not do so, his claims against 20 these Defendants would be dismissed without prejudice.

21 Plaintiff timely filed an amended complaint, and Defendants Select Portfolio Servicing, O'Brien, Miller and Hollingsworth However, Plaintiff did not offer proof that he timely answered. served Defendants Marshall, Encore Credit Corp. or Option One Mortgage Corp., and they have not appeared in this action. 26 Accordingly, Plaintiff's claims against these unserved Defendants 27 are dismissed without prejudice.
