11 On February 25, 2010, Plaintiff commenced the instant action against Washington Mutual
12 Bank (now JPMorgan Chase Bank (JP Morgan)), and a host of others, alleging that he was
13 defrauded in connection with the refinancing of his home. On the same date, Plaintiff filed an
14 Application for Temporary Restraining Order (TRO) and Motion for Preliminary Injunction.
15 (Docket 4.) The case initially was assigned to Judge Marilyn Hall Patel. Judge Patel subsequently
16 recused herself and the case was reassigned to the undersigned.

17 On March 19, 2010, Plaintiff filed a revised Application for Temporary Restraining Order
18 and Motion for Preliminary Injunction, in which he seeks to enjoin the non-judicial foreclosure sale
19 of his home scheduled for April 6, 2010. Defendant JP Morgan filed its Opposition to Plaintiff's
20 Request for TRO/Preliminary Injunction opposition on March 23, 2010. Accordingly,

21 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT Plaintiff shall file his reply brief by no later than the
22 close of business on April 1, 2010.
