While negotiating the final form of the 18 written settlement agreement, the parties discovered a 19 disagreement with respect to the tax withholding responsibilities 20 of the parties created as a result of the settlement. On June 5, 21 2014, after attempts to settle the dispute regarding the tax issue failed, Magistrate Judge Grewal issued an order resolving the 22 23 parties' dispute.1 24 <sup>1</sup> Magistrate Judge Grewal acted pursuant to the term sheet, 25 which provides, "To the extent disagreements arise during [the process of reducing the term sheet to a final writing], those

26 process of reducing the term sheet to a final writing], those disagreements will be resolved by Judge Paul Grewal; this resolution shall be final and non-appealable." Case No. 11-6121; Docket No. 501-4 at 4.
