**ORDER TO MEET AND CONFER RE
DISCOVERY DISPUTES**

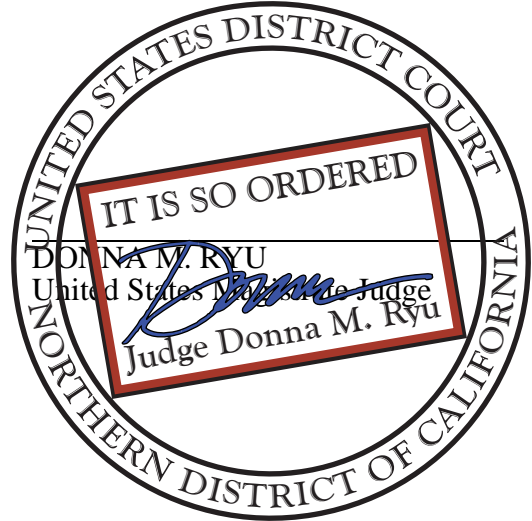
The Court is in receipt of the following submissions from the parties regarding discovery disputes: the parties' June 9, 2011 joint letter (Docket No. 143), Plaintiff Linda Terrell's June 9, 2011 letter (Docket No. 144), Defendants Fluor Construction, Gene Arceneaux and Harder Mechanical Contractors, Inc.'s June 9, 2011 letter (Docket No. 145) and Plaintiff's June 10, 2011 response thereto (Docket No. 146).

With respect to the disputes described in Docket Nos. 144, 145, and 146, it appears that the parties have not adequately engaged in thorough and meaningful meet and confer proceedings regarding the issues presented in the letters, as required by this Court's February 22, 2011 Standing Order. Therefore, the parties are ordered to meet and confer regarding the disputes in compliance with the Standing Order. If any disputes remain after the parties have met and conferred, the parties shall submit the dispute to the Court for resolution pursuant to the joint letter procedure described in the Standing Order **by no later than June 23, 2011**. Regarding the issue presented in Plaintiff's

1 June 9 letter (Docket No. 144), any joint letter regarding this dispute may not exceed five (5) pages.
2 Regarding the issues presented in Defendants' June 9 letter and Plaintiff's June 10 response thereto
3 (Docket Nos. 145 and 146), any joint letter regarding these disputes may not exceed ten (10) pages.
4 The Court notes that the parties' continued failure to follow the Court's Standing Order shall result
5 in sanctions.
