SCHEDULING ORDER

After consideration of the submissions by the parties, the Court orders as follows:

1. The Plaintiffs, the Defendants and the Defendant-Intervenor, the Bipartisan Legal Advisory Group of the United States House of Representatives (“the House”) (collectively “the parties”), shall exchange initial disclosures pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 26(a) on or before May 27, 2011.
2. As the parties have advised the Court that they have agreed to coordinate expert discovery and depositions (if any) in this case and in the case of *Windsor v. United States of America*, 10 Civ. 8435 (S.D.N.Y.) (BSJ)(JCF) so that any expert reports and any expert depositions may be used in both cases, the parties shall follow Paragraphs 2-3 and 5-7 of the Revised Scheduling Order of May 11, 2011, entered in *Windsor* (attached as Exhibit A).
3. The parties shall exchange all written requests for discovery (including document requests, interrogatories and requests for admissions pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 26, 33 and 36) on or before June 8, 2011.
4. All fact and expert discovery shall be complete by July 11, 2011.
