12 This action came on for trial before the Court and a jury,
13 Honorable Claudia Wilken, United States District Judge, presiding,
14 and the issues having been duly tried and the jury having duly
15 rendered its verdict, and this Court having previously issued its
16 Order Regarding Cross-Motions for Claim Construction and Summary
17 Judgment,

18 IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED

19 That judgment be entered in favor of Plaintiffs TransPerfect
20 Global, Inc., TransPerfect Translations International, Inc., and
21 Translations.com, Inc. (collectively, TransPerfect) on their claims
22 for infringement of their U.S. Patent No. 6,857,022;

23 That TransPerfect recover from the Defendant MotionPoint
24 Corporation the sum of \$1,002,006, with interest thereon as
25 provided by 28 U.S.C. § 1961, and their costs of action;

26 That judgment be entered in favor of TransPerfect on its
27 claims for declarations of invalidity;

28 That claims 16 and 18 of MotionPoint's U.S. Patent No.

1 7,627,479, claims 32 and 34 of MotionPoint's U.S. Patent No.
2 7,580,960, and claims 12 and 19 of MotionPoint's U.S. Patent No.
3 7,627,817 are hereby declared invalid;

4 That judgment be entered in favor of MotionPoint on its
5 counterclaims declaring that it does not infringe TransPerfect's
6 U.S. Patent Nos. 7,207,005 and 6,526,426.

7 MotionPoint shall take nothing on its infringement
8 counterclaims. A permanent injunction will enter separately.
