13 On March 2, 2012, Plaintiff Adobe Systems LLC and Defendants
14 Anthony Kornrumpf and Hoops Enterprise, LLC filed a stipulation
15 agreeing to a shortened notice period for Defendants' motion to
16 stay this action pending appeal of this Court's February 1, 2012
17 order granting Plaintiff's motion for partial summary judgment.
18 Specifically, the parties agreed that Defendants' motion could be
19 calendared for hearing seven days after it was filed. On March 6,
20 2012, Defendants filed their motion to stay and noticed it for
21 hearing on April 12, 2012.

22 The Court notes that it has not certified its February 1,
23 2012 order for interlocutory appeal under 28 U.S.C. § 1292(b) and
24 that it has not entered partial judgment under Federal Rule of
25 Civil Procedure 54(b).

26 Having considered the parties' stipulation, the Court ORDERS
27 that Plaintiff shall file its opposition to Defendants' motion to
28 stay, if any, within four days of the date of this Order. The

1 Court will decide Defendants' motion to stay on the papers. The
2 hearing currently set for April 12, 2012 is VACATED.

3 This Order terminates Docket No. 166.
