Because the only claimant in this action is also a fugitive who is being extradited from Canada, 1 the Court set the next case management conference for June 15, 2015. See Case Management Statement 2 3 of the United States, filed December 4, 2014; Order Continuing Case Management Conference, etc., filed December 5, 2014. To require the United States to go forward with a Settlement Conference and 4 5 prepare a Settlement Conference Statement would be unduly burdensome because it is unlikely that claimant will have been extradited from Canada. Fed. R. Civ. P. 1.
