1 is considered to be confidential, but rather must be supported by a 2 sworn declaration demonstrating with particularity the need to file 3 each document under seal. <u>See Civil L.R. 79-5(a)</u>. If a document 4 has been designated as confidential by another party, that party 5 must file a declaration establishing that the document is sealable. 6 Civil L.R. 79-5(d).

7 Because Defendants have failed to file a declaration as 8 required by Civil L.R. 79-5(d), Plaintiffs' motion is DENIED. 9 (Docket No. 64.) Within four days of the date of this Order, 10 Plaintiffs shall file unredacted versions of their documents in the 11 public record. Civil L.R. 79-5(e).
