11 Defendant's motion for summary judgment is fully briefed and
12 has been taken on the papers. On May 25, 2012, Plaintiff filed a
13 motion for judgment. No further opposition or reply is required
14 on this motion. In seven days, Defendant may file an opposition
15 of no more than five pages on new facts or law included in
16 Plaintiff's motion that were not addressed in the briefing on the
17 motion for summary judgment. If Defendant files an opposition,
18 Plaintiff may, four days thereafter, file a reply of not more than
19 three pages, similarly addressing only new facts or law addressed
20 in Defendant's brief. Both motions will be decided on the papers.
