1 Plaintiffs' motions for final approval of the settlement and
2 attorneys' fees, the Court informed Plaintiffs that their request
3 to seal was overbroad and unsupported. Much of the Heath
4 declaration contained non-sealable information appropriate for the
5 public record. Pursuant to the Court's instruction, on November
6 21, 2011, Diane Waller submitted a declaration, establishing that
7 a portion of the Heath declaration contains confidential
8 commercial information, and a redacted version of the declaration.
9 Having reviewed the submissions, the Court grants the motion to
10 seal the redacted portion of the Heath declaration under Civil
11 Local Rule 79-5(c).
