15 The Court has received and considered the parties' joint case management conference
16 statement. The Court VACATES the case management conference, and it HEREBY ORDERS
17 AS FOLLOWS:

18 1. If Plaintiff seeks to dismiss the remaining state law claim, she must file a motion
19 to dismiss by no later than August 1, 2014, and notice that motion for hearing on an open and
20 available date on this Court's law and motion calendar. "Remand" is not appropriate, because
21 the case was originally filed in this Court.

22 2. The only remaining claim in this court is Plaintiff's claim for sex discrimination
23 in violation of FEHA. If Plaintiff seeks leave to re-open discovery on that claim, the parties
24 should meet and confer and submit a joint letter brief setting forth their positions. The Court
25 shall not entertain a motion to re-open discovery on the issue of race discrimination, because
26 there is no such claim pending in this Court.

27 3. The Court sets the following dates:
28

- 1 a. The last day to hear dispositive motions shall be Friday, December 5, 2014 at
2 9:00 a.m.¹
- 3 b. The final pretrial conference shall be on Monday, January 26, 2015 at 2:00 p.m.
4 The parties shall familiarize themselves with the Court's Guidelines for Civil
5 Jury Trials.
- 6 c. The Court shall conduct jury selection on Wednesday, February 25, 2015 at 8:00
7 a.m.
- 8 d. The Court shall hold trial beginning on Monday, March 2, 2015 at 8:00 a.m.
