ORDER GRANTING
PLAINTIFF'S
UNOPPOSED MOTION TO
REMAND
(Docket No. 27)

11 On January 26, 2011, Plaintiff Raymond E. Horne filed his
12 amended complaint and motion to remand his action to Alameda County
13 Superior Court. His amended complaint asserts claims only against
14 Defendant District Council 16 International Union of Painters and
15 Allied Trades. On February 9, 2011, District Council 16 answered
16 Plaintiff's complaint and, on February 17, 2011, filed a statement
17 of non-opposition to Plaintiff's motion to remand.

18 Accordingly, the Court GRANTS Plaintiff's motion to remand.
19 (Docket No. 27.) The Clerk shall remand Plaintiff's action to
20 Alameda County Superior Court and, thereafter, close the file.

21 IT IS SO ORDERED.
