18 In its March 21, 2013 order, the Court conditionally granted  
19 Plaintiffs Alexander Graham-Sult and David Graham's motion to stay  
20 execution of the fee award. The Court ordered that the stay would  
21 be granted upon notice to the Court that Plaintiffs had posted a  
22 supersedeas bond in the amount of \$750,000. On March 27, 2013,  
23 Plaintiffs filed a notice of posting supersedeas bond on appeal.  
24 A copy of the bond in the amount of \$750,000 was attached to the  
25 notice, and Plaintiffs indicate that the original bond is on file  
26 with the Clerk of this Court.

27 Accordingly, the Court stays enforcement of its order dated  
28 March 23, 2012 granting Defendants' motions for attorneys' fees

1 and costs. (Docket No. 142). The stay is effective as of this  
2 date and shall remain in effect during the pendency of the appeal  
3 of the attorneys' fees award (Ninth Circuit Docket No. 12-15892).
