ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE REDISMISSAL

On July 25, 2012, the Court issued an order granting Plaintiff's motion for default judgment as to Toby Byron. Dkt. 73. As to remaining Defendant East Stinson Inc. ("East Stinson"), the Court granted Plaintiff's request for an additional thirty days to effect service on this Defendant. See Fed. R. Civ. P. 4(m). Failure to file a response by that date will result in the dismissal of the action. The Court will take the matter under submission as of the date the response is due.
