20 practices and unfair competition, under Cal. Bus. Prof. Code
21 §§ 17200 et seq. and common law; (2) false or misleading
22 advertising, under Cal. Bus. Prof. Code §§ 17500 et seq.;
23 (3) false advertising, under the Lanham Act § 43(a)(1)(B), 15
24 U.S.C. § 1125; and (4) violation of the Anti-Cybersquatting
25 Consumer Protection Act, under 15 U.S.C. § 1125(d), and

26 That Plaintiff's claims against Defendants for intentional
27 interference with prospective economic advantage and trade libel
28 are dismissed.

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The Court shall separately enter a Permanent Injunction.
