TRIAL LENGTH: 10 days


Parties are advised that while the Court set a trial date in this action, the trial date may be advanced if the calendar opens. Said trial date will not be sooner than eight (8) weeks after the close of discovery.

The parties shall provide the Court with the name of an agreed-upon mediator by August 3, 2012 by filing a JOINT Notice. A compliance hearing regarding shall be held on Friday, August 10, 2012 on the Court's 9:01a.m. calendar, in the Federal Courthouse, 1301 Clay Street, Oakland, California, in a courtroom to be designated. By August 3, 2012, the parties shall file either the JOINT Notice or a one-page JOINT STATEMENT setting forth an explanation for their failure to comply. If compliance is complete, the parties need not appear and the compliance hearing will be taken off calendar. Telephonic appearances will be allowed if the parties have submitted a joint statement in a timely fashion.
