ORDER DENYING AS PREMATURE
PLAINTIFF'S REQUEST FOR
EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE
OPPOSITION TO DEFENDANTS'
DISPOSITIVE MOTION

Plaintiff has filed a request for an extension of time in which to file his opposition to Defendants' dispositive motion. Having read and considered Plaintiff's request, and good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Plaintiff's request for an extension of time is DENIED as premature, as Defendants have not yet filed a dispositive motion.
