 14 On May 10, 2012, the Court held a case management conference
 15 and, among other things, set a briefing schedule for the parties'
 16 cross-motions for summary judgment. Pursuant to that schedule,
 17 Defendant Alexander Yin was required to file his opposition to
 18 Plaintiff Allstate Insurance Company's motion for summary judgment
 19 and his cross-motion for summary judgment "contained in a single
 20 brief." Docket No. 55.

21 The parties subsequently stipulated to continue the briefing
 22 schedule, with Court approval. See Docket Nos. 59, 60, 62, 63.
 23 Under the modified schedule, Defendant was required to file his
 24 opposition and cross-motion by January 24, 2013. Docket No. 63.
 25 Plaintiff was required to file its reply in support of its motion
 26 and opposition to Defendant's cross-motion, contained in a single
 27 brief, by January 31, 2013. Id.

United States District Court
 For the Northern District of
 California

1 On January 25, 2013, one day after its filing deadline,
2 Defendant filed two separate briefs: an opposition to Plaintiff's
3 motion for summary judgment and a separate cross-motion for
4 summary judgment. Docket Nos. 83 and 85.

5 The Court STRIKES the separate briefs filed by Defendant
6 (Docket Ns. 83 and 85) and RESETS the briefing schedule on the
7 cross-motions for summary judgment as follows: Defendant shall
8 file a single brief, of twenty-five pages or less, containing its
9 opposition and cross-motion, by Monday, January 28, 2013.
10 Plaintiff shall file its reply and opposition to Defendant's
11 cross-motion, contained in a single brief of fifteen pages or
12 less, by Monday, February 4, 2013. Defendant shall file its reply
13 in support of its cross-motion, in a brief of fifteen pages or
14 less, by Monday, February 11, 2013. The hearing and further case
15 management conference currently for March 7, 2013 at 2:00 p.m. are
16 maintained.
