Motion, 18 ECF No. 5. At the hearing, the court discussed with the parties the option of participating in the 19 court's alternative dispute resolution ("ADR") program. The court specifically noted that by 20 participating in an ADR session, Mercedes-Benz would not waive its right to compel Mr. Mance to 21 arbitrate his claims. 22 After this discussion, the parties agreed to participate in court-sponsored mediation and to take a 23 limited amount of discovery to make the mediation session useful. The parties stated that they 24 would file a stipulation documenting their agreement. Accordingly, the court refers the parties to 25 mediation, which shall take place within 90 days from the date of this order. The parties shall notify 26 the court promptly if the case resolves. 27 The court also set a status conference for January 19, 2012 at 10:30 a.m. 10/20/2011 Minute 28 Order, ECF No. 16. The parties were instructed to file a joint status conference statement no later

than January 12, 2012. *Id.* In light of these next steps, the court defers ruling on Mercedes-Benz's motion to compel until after the status conference.
