judges.¹ When the parties meet and confer, the parties also must discuss the parties' availabilities for alternate trial dates.

Within 7 days of the date of this Order:

- The parties shall advise the Court whether they will consent to try this case before a magistrate judge if a magistrate judge can guarantee a specific trial date. If so, the parties may provide a list of those magistrate judges to whom they will agree to consent. The Court will then advise the parties whether their choice of magistrate judge(s) can guarantee their trial date.
- 2) If the parties do not agree to consent to a magistrate judge for trial, the parties shall contact Frances Stone, the Court Room Deputy, to schedule a case management conference for trial setting purposes to occur within 30 days of the date of this Order. The Court holds case management conferences on Mondays at 2:00 p.m.
