Having considered the motion to withdraw as counsel for
Defendants The Milan Group, Inc. and Frank Lorenzo Pavlico III,
sued as Frank Lorenzo, and found good cause therefore, the Court
GRANTS the motion.

The Court hereby ORDERS that, pursuant to Civil Local Rule
11-5(a), Andrew J. Piunti, Veronika Short and the law firm of DPA
Law Group are hereby terminated as counsel for The Milan Group,
Inc. and Lorenzo in this matter. Pursuant to Civil Local Rule
11-5(b), their withdrawal is subject to the condition that papers
may continue to be served on them for forwarding purposes to The

1 Milan Group, Inc., unless and until The Milan Group, Inc. appears
2 by other counsel.

3 The Court notes that, as a corporation, The Milan Group, Inc.
4 cannot represent itself and will be in default if it fails to
5 appear through counsel and meet its obligations in the litigation.

6 Unless and until other counsel enters an appearance on behalf
7 of Lorenzo, other parties are required to serve documents upon him
8 directly. The Court notes that Lorenzo's former counsel provided
