For the reasons set forth in the Court's Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law,

IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED

That judgment be entered in favor of Plaintiffs SunEarth, Inc. and The Solaray Corporation on their claims for (1) trademark and trade name infringement under the Lanham Act, 15 U.S.C. §§ 1125(a), et seq., California law, Cal. Bus. & Prof. C. §§ 14415 and 14402, and common law and (2) cybersquatting under the Anticybersquatting Consumer Protection Act, 15 U.S.C. § 1125(d), as to the sun-earth.us domain only, and

That Defendants' counterclaims against Plaintiffs are dismissed with prejudice.

The Court shall separately enter a Permanent Injunction.

Plaintiffs shall recover their costs from Defendants.
