personal attendance by the parties. The court only grants permission to appear by telephone upon
 submission of a timely written request that demonstrates extraordinary hardship. The court notes
 that Plaintiff has been previously admonished for repeated failures to follow court directives, which
 resulted in the court's dismissal of the case in December 2012. [Docket No. 39.]

Accordingly, Plaintiff's request to continue the settlement conference is DENIED. The parties and counsel are ordered to appear in person on June 28, 2013 at 11:00 a.m. in accordance with the court's May 2, 2013 order.
