17 On May 31, 2012, Defendants Sand Canyon Corporation, formerly
18 known as Option One Mortgage Corporation, Dale Sugimoto, and
19 Matthew Engel filed a motion to dismiss the complaint.

20 Plaintiffs' response was due by June 18, 2012. See Federal Rule
21 of Civil Procedure 6(d); Civil Local Rule 7-3(a).

22 On June 20, 2012, the Court granted Plaintiffs one additional
23 week in which to file their response to Defendants' motion to
24 dismiss. At that time, the Court warned Plaintiffs that failure
25 to file a response would result in the dismissal of their claims
26 against these Defendants for failure to prosecute.

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Plaintiffs have not filed a response to Defendants' motion. Accordingly, the Court dismisses Plaintiffs' claims against Sand Canyon Corporation, Sugimoto and Engel for failure to prosecute.

This Order resolves Docket No. 16.
