11 On July 13, 2012, Defendants U.S. Bank, N.A. and Recontrust
12 Company, N.A. moved to dismiss the claims asserted against them by
13 pro se Plaintiff Eduardo Alguero. Docket No. 11.

14 On July 31, 2012, the Court noted that Plaintiff had not
15 filed an opposition to the motion to dismiss within the time
16 period set forth in Civil Local Rule 7-3(a). Docket No. 15. At
17 that time, the Court allowed Plaintiff until August 7, 2012 to
18 file an opposition. The Court also warned him that failure to
19 file an opposition in compliance with that Order would result in
20 the dismissal of his case for failure to prosecute.

21 As of the date of this Order, Plaintiff has not filed an
22 opposition to Defendants' motion to dismiss. Accordingly, the
23 Court DISMISSES Plaintiff's action without prejudice for failure
24 to prosecute.
