PITMAN: 12 You are **Ordered To Show Cause** why you should not be sanctioned for failure to complete 13 compliance with the terms of the settlement agreement reached in the settlement conference held 14 before Magistrate Judge Jacqueline Scott Corley on September 13, 2013. The Court previously 15 continued the compliance hearing in this matter from January 24, 2014, to February 21, 2014, based 16 upon the representation of the United States and its counsel that it was "working on processing the 17 remaining payments and is hopeful that they will be released soon." (Dkt. No. 40.) The parties have 18 now filed an new joint statement making the identical representation, with no further explanation for 19 the delay, and seeking an additional four weeks for compliance. (Dkt. No. 42.) 20 Counsel for Defendant and the person most knowledgeable for defendant the United States 21 shall appear personally on **Friday**, **February 28**, **2014**, **at 9:01 a.m.** in Courtroom 5 prepared to 22 explain the lengthy delay in completing the terms of the settlement herein. If payment is completed, 23 in fact, prior to the hearing, the matter shall be taken off calendar and the Order to Show Cause 24 vacated. 25 IT IS SO ORDERED. 26 Dated: Friday, February 14, 2014 27
