By February 25, 2013, each party and/or counsel must file either: (1) a Case Management Statement, which includes a statement that they have reviewed the Local Rules with respect to their responsibilities; or (2) a written response to this Order to Show Cause why they should not be sanctioned for their failure to timely file a Case Management Statement. Failure to file a Case Management Statement, written

response or to appear personally will be deemed an admission that no good cause exists and that the imposition of monetary sanctions is appropriate.
