12 On March 20, 2013, the Court extended the deadline for
13 Plaintiff Jerome L. Grimes to serve Defendants Officers Barber,
14 Smith and Tang until May 28, 2013. Docket No. 36.

15 Plaintiff now moves for an additional sixty days in which to
16 serve these Defendants. Plaintiff explains that he is still being
17 held in the trial competency program of the Napa State Hospital
18 and that he "appears to be, In-Route, to be discharged" from this
19 program. Mot. at 2-3.

20 Accordingly, the Court GRANTS Plaintiff's motion and extends
21 time for service upon Officers Barber, Smith and Tang until July
22 29, 2013.

1 By that date, Plaintiff must file either proof of service
2 upon each of these Defendants or a motion for additional time in
3 which to serve them, in which he provides good cause for the
4 failure to serve them within the allowed time period. Plaintiff's
5 failure to comply with the terms of this Order will result in
6 dismissal of his claims for failure to prosecute.
