ORDER STRIKING FILING, DOCKET NO. 49,  
ON THE COURT'S OWN MOTION

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13 Plaintiff Anthony L. Williams ("Plaintiff") filed "A Notice to All Parties in the Above  
14 Entitled Action" on November 21, 2012. (Dkt No. 49, "Notice".) The Notice purports to stay these  
15 proceedings "until such time as the Justice Department can order a Case Remand back to State  
16 Jurisdiction (28 U.S.C. 2283)." It goes on to state that "[n]o further filings, actions or orders,  
17 including filings by any Defendant is permitted EXCEPT an Order of Remand By the District  
18 Court."

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20 The Court, on its own motion, **STRIKES** the Notice as filed improperly and without supporting  
21 authority. The authority cited by Plaintiff, 28 U.S.C. § 2283, states only that a federal court may not  
22 enjoin state court proceedings except under limited circumstances. There is no injunction of state  
23 court proceedings at issue here. Moreover, the Court is aware of no legal basis warranting a stay of  
24 the order denying Plaintiff's Motion for Remand.
