**ORDER DIRECTING PARTIES TO MEET AND
CONFER REGARDING FORM OF ORDER ON
MOTION FOR PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION**

12 The Court is in receipt of a Notice of Decision by Defendant United States Postal Service to
13 Postpone Reassignment of American Postal Workers Union Represented Employees (Dkt. No. 45)
14 and Plaintiffs' Response to Defendant's Notice (Dkt. No. 49).

15 Accordingly, the parties are **ORDERED TO MEET AND CONFER** regarding a form of order on
16 Plaintiffs' Motion for Preliminary Injunction, which seeks to enjoin Defendant from subcontracting
17 truck driving routes until a grievance is resolved through an arbitration scheduled for November 27
18 and November 28, 2012, in light of the notification by Defendant that "[i]f the Postal Service
19 decides to transition to highway contract routes, any impacted APWU-represented employees will
20 remain in their current positions until they are scheduled for reassignment, which will be no earlier
21 than January 26, 2013, consistent with the provisions of Article 12 of the National Agreement."

22 If said form of order is filed in advance of the hearing on preliminary injunction, then the
23 hearing will be taken off calendar. If the parties need additional time to file said form of order, the
24 parties should advise the Court of same, and the Court can continue the hearing. Otherwise the
25 hearing shall take place as scheduled.

26 **IT IS SO ORDERED.**
