
**ORDER TO DEFENDANTS TO SHOW

On August 18, 2017, Defendants filed their reply in support of their motion for summary judgment. Defendants also filed objections to the evidence submitted by Plaintiffs. Under Northern District Civil Local Rule 7-3(c), “[a]ny evidentiary and procedural objections to the opposition must be contained within the reply brief or memorandum.” Defendants did not comply with that rule.
