14 This action was opened on August 29, 2013, when a letter
15 sent by Plaintiff to the Court was construed as an attempt by
16 Plaintiff to file a civil rights action under 42 U.S.C. § 1983.

17 On the same day the action was opened, the Clerk of the
18 Court sent a notice to Plaintiff, informing him that he must file
19 his claims on a civil rights complaint form. The Clerk also sent
20 Plaintiff a notice informing him that his case could not go
21 forward until he paid the filing fee or filed a completed
22 prisoner's in forma pauperis (IFP) application. The notice
23 stated that, if Plaintiff did not submit the required documents
24 within twenty-eight days from the date of the notice, his action
25 would be dismissed and the file closed. The Clerk sent Plaintiff
26 a blank civil rights complaint form as well as a blank IFP
27 application.
