ORDER GRANTING IN  
PART PLAINTIFF'S  
MOTION FOR  
EXTENSION OF TIME  
(Docket No. 30)

11 Plaintiff Danilo Mallari, proceeding pro se, moves for an  
12 extension of time to file his second amended complaint.  
13 Specifically, he requests a fourteen-day extension of time so that  
14 he can "secure additional vital documents and pieces of real  
15 evidence to support the filing of the second amended complaint"  
16 and "obtain the written statements of potential witnesses not  
17 available at the time the first complaint was filed." Docket No.  
18 30, Mot. Ext. Time, at 8. Because Mallari does not need to submit  
19 any "real evidence" or "witness statements" with his amended  
20 pleading, a fourteen-day extension is not justified here.  
21 Nevertheless, the Court will grant him a brief extension of five  
22 days because he is proceeding pro se and may need additional time  
23 to prepare the complaint. Accordingly, Plaintiffs' second amended  
24 complaint is now due on or before March 17, 2014.
