 22 and through undersigned counsel, have conferred and agreed to the following stipulation:

23 1. By order dated October 18, 2013, the Court set a briefing schedule for the  
 24 order to show cause why a preliminary injunction should not issue and indicated that the  
 25 parties could “stipulate to an alternate briefing schedule, including an extension of the

3 2. The parties have conferred and agreed to an alternate briefing schedule.  
4 Subject to the approval of the Court, the government will file its response to the order to  
5 show cause why a preliminary injunction should not issue on November 4, 2013;  
6 Plaintiffs will file their reply on November 11, 2013; and the hearing on Plaintiffs'  
7 motion will be November 14, 2013 at 2:00pm.

8 3. The temporary restraining order entered October 18, 2013 shall be extended  
9 for an additional 14 days and accordingly shall expire on November 15, 2013.
