**ORDER RE: PLAINTIFFS' REQUEST
FOR TELEPHONIC DISCOVERY
CONFERENCE**

Re: Dkt. No. 84

On June 5, 2015, Plaintiffs filed a Request for a Telephonic Discovery Conference concerning the deposition of Alex Himel, Defendant Facebook Inc.'s declarant for documents Facebook recently produced to Plaintiffs. Dkt. No. 84. Facebook submitted a response the same day. Dkt. No. 85. Mr. Himel is evidently unavailable for deposition until July 8, 2015, although the only description for why he is unavailable is an email exchange between the parties' counsel in which Facebook's counsel states that "Mr. Himel is a senior Facebook employee who manages a team of dozens of people and does not have requisite availability for a deposition before then." Rudolph Decl., Ex. A, Dkt. No. 84-2. To assist the Court in resolving this matter, Facebook has until tomorrow, June 9, 2015 at 5:00 p.m. to file a declaration explaining why Mr. Himel is unavailable until July 8, 2015.
