Pending before the Court is the parties' Joint Discovery Letter, in which Plaintiffs seek an Order allowing co-Plaintiff David Shadpour to withdraw from the case pursuant to Federal Rules of Civil Procedure 21 or 41(a)(2), while Defendant Facebook Inc. seeks an Order compelling Mr. Shadpour to sit for deposition and provide discovery responses to outstanding requests before withdrawing from this action.
