**ORDER DENYING AS MOOT
MOTION TO DISMISS AND
NOTICE TO PARTIES RE PAGE
LIMITATIONS**

On May 5, 2014, Defendants filed a motion to dismiss Plaintiff’s complaint, which was noticed for hearing on June 20, 2014. (Docket No. 10.) On May 19, 2014, Plaintiff filed an amended complaint.
