18 Defendant Kristi Luhar filed a motion for summary judgment on July 29, 2014. (Dkt. No.  
19 53.) The filing does not comply with this Court's Standing Order in Civil Cases at paragraph 9(a).  
20 The motion is **STRICKEN** on those grounds.<sup>1</sup>

21 The Court further notes that the motion does not comply with this Court's Standing Order in  
22 Civil Cases at paragraph 9(c) (requiring a separate statement of facts), and the declaration in support  
23 does not comply with Civil Local Rule 79-5 concerning submission under seal of evidence in a  
24 redacted form. Counsel must correct such deficiencies in any future filing.

25 The Clerk shall strike Dkt. No. 53 from the record.
