16	This matter comes before the Court upon consideration of the Report and
17	Recommendation ("Report") prepared by Magistrate Judge Vadas (ECF No. 72), in which
18	he recommends that the Court grant Plaintiff's motion for default judgment (ECF No. 63), and
19	enter judgment against Defendant Tong as follows:
20	Tong, and those acting at his direction, be forever enjoined from: (1) using Magpul's trademarks in connection with the sale of any
21	unauthorized goods; (2) infringing upon the Magpul Marks; (3) unfairly competing with Magpul; (4) falsely representing themselves as being connected with Magpul; (5) using any
22 23	themselves as being connected with Magpul; (5) using any reproduction, counterfeit, copy or colorable imitation of Magpul's trademarks in connection with publicity, promotion, or sale of
23 24	goods, and; (6) affixing, applying, annexing, or using in connection with the sale of any goods, a false description or
25	representation that describe or represent such goods as being those of Magpul; and \$120,000.00 in monetary damages.
26	(ECF No. 72 at 13.)
27	The deadline for filing objections to the Report has passed, and neither party has filed
28	objections. The Court has considered the Report, relevant legal authority, and the record in this

case. The Court finds the Report thorough and well reasoned and adopts it in every respect. Accordingly, the Court GRANTS Plaintiff's motion for default judgment. IT IS SO ORDERED. - Stoket Dated: December 16, 2014 JEFFREY S UNITED ST ÎTE S DISTRICT JUDGE
