ORDER REQUIRING SUPPLEMENTAL BRIEFING

The Court held a hearing on the parties' cross-motions for partial summary judgment on July 30, 2015. In light of the arguments advanced by counsel at the hearing, the Court orders the parties to brief whether summary judgment is appropriate as to the claims associated with any mark other than Plaintiffs' "Farmer's Burger" mark—be it because those claims have been abandoned or because the claims have been insufficiently briefed by Plaintiffs. Each side, not each party, shall file a supplemental brief of no more than 10 pages, complete with specific references to the existing record, within 14 days of this order. In lieu of filing supplemental briefs, the parties may elect to file a stipulation of dismissal regarding these claims, and any others that should be dismissed prior to trial.
