STOLTE, 10 Defendant. 11 12 13 Defendant Jeffrey M. Stolte removed this unlawful detainer action from Contra Costa Superior Court on May 9, 2014. (Notice of Removal, Dkt. No. 1.) He proceeds pro se. In the 14 15 notice of removal, Defendant states that this Court has diversity jurisdiction over this case. District courts have jurisdiction over civil actions where there is complete diversity of 16 citizenship among the parties and the amount in controversy exceeds \$75,000, exclusive of interest 17 18 and costs. 28 U.S.C. § 1332(a). In the complaint, Plaintiff alleges that the amount in controversy 19 does not exceed \$25,000. Therefore, Defendant is ordered to show cause why this case should not 20 be remanded to Contra Costa County Superior Court for lack of federal jurisdiction.
