Pursuant to the stipulation of defendants Select Portfolio Servicing, Inc. (“SPS”) and U.S. Bank National Association, as Trustee, successor in interest to Bank of America, National Association, as Trustee, successor by merger to LaSalle Bank NA, as Trustee for WaMu Mortgage Pass-Through Certificates Series 2006-AR15 (erroneously sued as U.S. Bank, N.A.) (hereinafter “U.S. Bank”) (collectively with SPS, “Defendants”) and plaintiffs Brit A. Borhaug and Jan Borhaug

1 (“Plaintiffs”) (collectively with Defendants, the “Parties”), and good cause appearing, the Court  
2 orders as follows:

- 3           1.       Litigation in this case will be temporarily stayed while the Parties continue to  
4 participate in the Court’s ADR Program.
- 5           2.       Defendants’ deadline to respond to the First Amended Complaint shall be continued  
6 to August 17, 2015;
- 7           3.       The Case Management Conference presently on calendar for July 28, 2015 shall be  
8 continued to September 29, 2015.
- 9           4.       The parties shall file a joint status report within 14 days of their next ADR Phone
