11	This case was opened when plaintiff wrote a letter to the court regarding his health.
12	In an effort to protect his rights, it was filed as a new case. Plaintiff was informed that he
13	had not filed a complaint and was given twenty-eight days to do so. He also was sent a
14	notice that he had not paid the filing fee or applied for leave to proceed in forma pauperis
15	("IFP"); again, he was allowed twenty-eight days to either pay the fee or file the application.

17	A copy of the court's form for applications to proceed IFP was provided with the notice,
18	along with a return envelope.
19	Plaintiff has not filed a complaint, an IFP application, or otherwise communicated
20	with the court. This case is therefore <b>DISMISSED</b> without prejudice. No fee is due. The
21	clerk shall close the file.
